7. Public Hearings (Pursuant to the *Planning Act*)

(a) Report and Resolution re: Amendment to Zoning By-law No. 2002-28, as amended - RZ-05-18 (STROYAN)

Mayor Thrale stated that this was a Public Meeting for a Zoning By-law amendment held by Council under Section 34 of the *Planning Act*. Mayor Thrale then declared the Public Meeting open at 6:54 p.m., to consider a proposed rezoning of lands located in Part of Lots 2 & 3, Concession 12, Lot 2, Plan M-647 (206 Riverside Drive) in the Geographic Township of Bethune, now in the Town of Kearney from the Residential Waterfront Exception Eight (RWF-8) Zone to the RESIDENTIAL Waterfront Exception Forty-nine (RWF-49) Zone.

The Mayor asked the Planning Technician to explain the purpose of the proposed rezoning.

The Planning Technician stated that the purpose of the amendment is to permit a secondary dwelling unit above an accessory building (garage) and to permit a building height of 7.92 metres for the accessory building and dwelling unit.

The Mayor asked if any written concerns been received.

The Planning Technician stated that no written concerns have been received.

The Mayor asked if the applicant wished to make any comments.

The applicant stated that they did not wish to make any comments at this time.

The Mayor asked if anyone wished to speak in opposition of the proposed rezoning.

There were no opposing comments.

The Mayor asked if anyone wished to speak in favour of the proposed rezoning.

There were no submissions.

The Mayor asked if Council had any questions. There were no questions from Council.

The Mayor asked if there were any further comments or questions from the public. There were no further comments.

Mayor Thrale asked if the Planning Technician had anything further to add.

The Planning Technician had nothing further to add.

Mayor Thrale asked if Council had any further questions.

There were no further questions from Council .


