7. Public Hearings (Pursuant to the *Municipal Act*)

(a) Report and Resolution re: Original Shore Road Allowance Purchase (ELTON)

Mayor Thrale stated that we have before us a request to purchase part of the Original Shore Road Allowance in front of Lots 13 & 14, Concession 2, Part 5, Plan 42R-16622 in the geographic Township of Proudfoot, designated as Part 1, Plan 42R-21073.

The Mayor asked if the Planning Technician has received any written concerns.

The Planning Technician stated that a concern was received from the adjacent property owners, Mr. & Mrs. Haun, who advised that they are opposed to the purchase as they have well established pedestrian trails on the lands and request that the shore road allowance remain in public ownership. Council received the letter of objection and passed a Resolution at the April 6th Council meeting approving the application in principle and requesting that Mr. Elton determine whether Mr. & Mrs. Haun would like a deeded right-of-way at their expense. The Hauns were notified of Council's decision. The Hauns declined the offer to obtain a right-of-way due to the cost of a survey. No other concerns or objections were received from the public or agencies circulated.

The Mayor asked if the applicant was present, if the applicant would like to make any comments.

The applicant was not present.

The Mayor asked if anyone wished to make representation on the proposed By-law for the closure and sale of the shore road allowance.

There were no representations.

The Mayor asked if Council had any questions. There were no questions from Council.

Mayor Thrale asked if the Planning Technician had anything further to add.


The Planning Technician had nothing further to add.
