RE: Sand Lake Boat Ramp

Dear Madam Mayor, Town Councillors and Staff,

On December 12, 2023, SLAPOA submitted a letter to the Town, on behalf of its members, requesting further information about the design and cost of the Sand Lake Boat Ramp reconstruction. Since that time, Council has decided that because the scope of work had been changed since the work was awarded to Galcon Marine, Resolution 334-23 was passed at the December 14, 2023, meeting requiring Tatham Engineering to submit a simplified design for the Boat Ramp.

SLAPOA would have liked to comment on the simplified design at the February 1, 2024 Council Meeting, but it's our understanding that the design was not provided to the Town until late last week, and Town Staff had not had a chance to review it as of the cut off for public submissions to the agenda. We still hope to review the plan when it is available to the public, and we hope that the Town and Council also closely review it before making any decision about the Boat Ramp design.

As we said in our previous letter, since the Tatham design was the sole submission to the Town for consideration, SLAPOA feels that it would be fiscally responsible for the Town to engage an outside firm for a professional review of both the Tatham and Skelton proposals. While it may not be possible for a full peer review to be done on this project if the Town wishes to meet the timelines necessary to have the Boat Ramp completed for use this summer, and while it may not be necessary to have a peer review for the Skelton design if Tatham's simplified design is substantially similar, SLAPOA still stresses the importance of having capital projects peer reviewed.

Having said that, at the October 19, 2023, Council Meeting, Resolution 280-23 was passed directing staff to bring back a policy on utilizing peer-review engineering services for future infrastructure projects. SLAPOA would like to request an update on this policy, especially in light of the fact that the current contract with Tatham Engineering expires in April 2024, and the Town has an opportunity in the subsequent engineer of record contract to require peer reviews.

In our previous letter we also noted that at the November 27, 2023, Special Meeting Agenda there was a line item on the for \$411,000.00 (in season), and \$574,000.00 (in winter) for the Sand Lake Boat Ramp replacement. The notes indicate that those amounts do not include the



engineering or craning costs incurred to date. Since no additional details were provided on the agenda regarding the \$411,000.00, we would still like to request a detailed breakdown of the budgeted cost. In addition, the payment registers presented to Council do not itemize the Tatham payments by project, so we also request a breakdown of the spending to date, so we have an understanding of the true costs of the project.

Finally, SLAPOA would like to receive detailed information, as soon as it is available, that we can provide to our members about the arrangements that will be put in place to allow the public to use the Sand Lake Boat Ramp this spring and summer, both before and during the reconstruction.

5. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

a) **Update on 'Local Share'**

MAHC has selected the site for the Bracebridge location- 300 Pine Street. The next stage of the project requires discussions as to what services will be housed in which location. Determination of services at each location is still under discussion. There have been no concrete decisions made at this time. User Groups are assisting in the determination. Note that Emergency services are not on table for discussion – Emergency will be available at both locations. MAHC will visit communities early this new year to receive feedback on the matter. When the community meetings are announced, please share widely.

b) **Progress Report:** R. Ward provided the group with an overview of the Progress Report.

Potential Health and Wellness Centre

The individual with interest in building the health and wellness centre in Armour is collecting costing and pulling together a business plan. Armour is looking at how the funding model could work and the feasibility of the options (i.e. is there an approach that makes sense for the region?). They are working through scenarios and hope to bring information to the table soon.

This discussion led to another regarding the current Burk's Falls building and the ability for an expansion, what Burk's Falls plans are for the building. It was noted that the replacement of the x-ray machine has prompted a lot of thought about healthcare in the area. All options must be a coordinated with a view to the future. Is there room for expansion on the new potential build in Armour if it is needed? What would it take to expand the current Burk's Falls location? The group agrees they need to work towards a mutual plan both model and structure. Council will keep their focus on Almaguin wide healthcare and not on one building. The solutions need to stand the test of time.

c) **Other business**

Promotional Material for Healthcare Recruitment

ACED was approached by S. Keast, HHR Recruiter with the MAOHT to develop a promotional tool for Almaguin. A draft brochure was shared. Feedback included images that better represent the facilities, wording/contact adjustments, and service changes. C. Metcalf collected feedback from the group and will use it to prepare a new draft. The brochure will also be shared with R. Paul and S. McKinnon for their FHT input. Once complete it would be a product used in a variety of formats including social media.

C. Metcalf will attain quotes on a finished glossy product. If the Recruiter budget is used for printing it is said there will be less money to attend events as it is the same budget.

The goal would be to have the brochure available for recruitment events scheduled end of January and beginning of February.

Branding Support Request from the Burk's Falls Family Health Team

The Burk's Falls Family Health Team is without branding or a website. They have been able to attain a grant from ACED for \$3000.00 for a branding project but are short approx. \$4300.00 to complete it. They are seeking assistance from the AHH Council for the remaining balance. After discussion about funds remaining in the bank account which contains only \$4767.00 of unallocated funds, the Council determined they would be comfortable to provide \$2000.00 towards the project considering there may be future requests from others for branding, or additional requests for support from other Almaguin communities.

Unused OTN Funds

C. Barr will contact Machar and South River regarding their \$2500.00 donations towards OTN replacement and if they agree to redirect the funds towards other initiatives related to healthcare in Almaguin. Initial request was not responded to.

Funding for Health Care initiatives in Almaguin

N. Hofstetter presented the idea of requesting \$1000.00 annually from the 10 municipal councils that would be held in the AHHC account for future requests. The requests may include subsidies for new providers as was done for the dentist in Burk's Falls, or for requests from Health Teams etc. It was suggested that a process for approving, and review requests be established for equity. The funds would be considered for all the Almaguin communities. \$1000.00 requested annually would potentially provide \$10,000.00 and eliminate the individual requests to Council, streamlining the process.

Subject: New Vehicle Purchases for Public Works

Recommendation:

That Council receive this report and approve the quotations from Mac Lang Dodge to purchase a New 2023 RAM 1500 Express Crew Cab 4X4 series pick-up in the amount of \$54,762 plus HST and a F-250 series crew cab in the amount of \$74,010.95.

Background:

Public Works is operating with 1 pick-up truck, Dodge Ram 2021 (4x4) with half cab that is utilized by the Working Foreperson for maintenance and snow removal/sanding within the old Town proper. A 2012 GMC Sierra was active till the end of December 2021 when it was parked. Staff in late 2023 placed it on Gov-Deals to be sold. Parks is operating with 1 pick-up truck, 2014 Ford F-150 2-wheel drive with a short cab (102,697kms.). Once a week the Transfer Station Staff use this Parks truck to pick up recycling and waste in the Town proper area.

Analysis:

To properly run the Public Works Department, it is necessary to upgrade the current fleet. The Working Foreperson's present vehicle does not satisfy the needs nor has the capability to place more than two (2) members of Staff to carry out their daily duties. With the addition of the Public Works Superintendent, jobs and duties will change daily, for example; Minimum Maintenance Standards road survey patrols that are provincially mandated, multiple crews working at different locations, onsite inspections of Tendered works being carried out properly (potentially more than 1 site ongoing), ability to check on and manage the proficiency, productiveness as well as health and safety of Staff, maintain and handle emergencies and Resident concerns, etc... all will be limited and hindered with just the one vehicle. The Parks/Transfer Station vehicle is a 2014 and needs to be updated to the proper vehicle to be able to maintain their general daily duties.

The natural succession of vehicles should start with the Public Works Department due to the size and scope of work needed and work down to the Parks and Recreation/Transfer Station Department. Upon purchase the current Public Works Forepersons 2022 vehicle will go to Parks Staff. Transfer Station Attendant will then have the 2014 Ford F-150 to facilitate curbside collection and transportation between Transfer Station sites. The low mileage on the vehicle only makes sense to have it remain active. Staff believe this Parks truck can work for curbside collection with the addition of snow tires. This Parks truck currently only has all season tires and does not have 4 Wheel Drive. Staff obtained rough quotes in December 2023 for new snow tires, installed on rims for just under \$2,000.00. We believe this truck could then be placed in at the King William Transfer Station to provide for a vehicle for the Transfer Station Staff to complete curbside pick-up, pick up supplies or waste as needed and give a municipal means of transportation between Transfer Station sites.

Financial Implications:

Following the January 18th Capital Budget meeting and Council's direction to obtain quotations, Staff obtained three quotes for these trucks all with roughly the same level trim (quotes are attached):

FORD:

NEW 2023 FORD F-150: \$61,241.95 plus HST

NEW 2023 FORD F-250: \$72,510.95 plus HST

DODGE:

NEW 2023 RAM 1500 Express Crew Cab 4X4: \$54,762 plus HST

NEW 2024 RAM 2500 BIG HORN CREW CAB 4X4 WHITE: \$78,275 plus HST

USED 2023 RAM 2500 TRADESMAN CREW CAB 4X4 WHITE: \$64,175 plus HST

NEW 2024 RAM 2500 TRADESMAN CREW CAB 4X4 – WHITE: \$81,884 plus HST

CHEV:

NEW 2024 SILVERADO 1500: \$67,693 plus HST

NEW 2024 SILVERADO 2500HD: \$82,015 plus HST

Conclusion:

At this time, Staff feels that new trucks make the most sense to ensure proper care and maintenance has been completed and invest properly in the asset. Therefore, Staff would recommend that the Town purchase the New 1500 Dodge Ram and the New FORD F-250 to add to the Public Works Fleet.

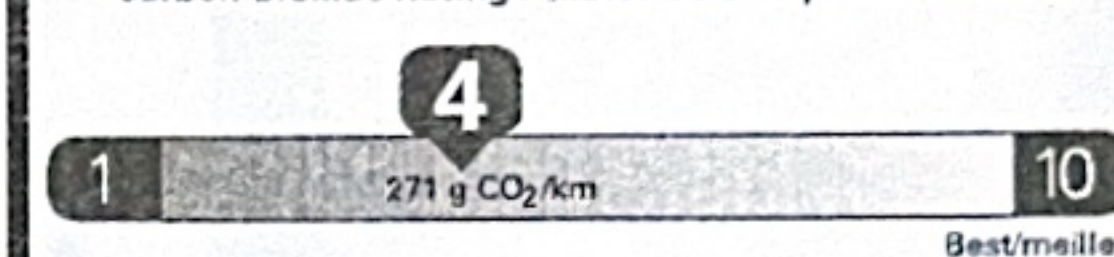

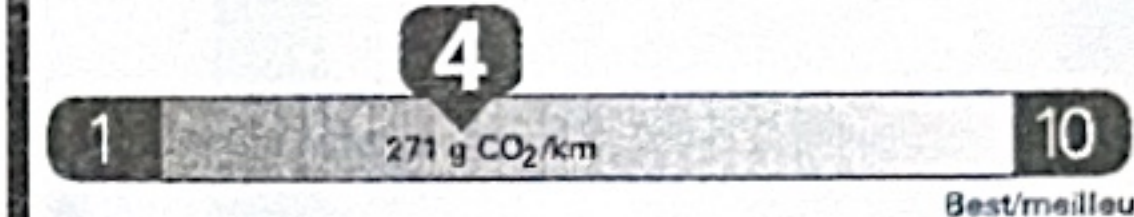

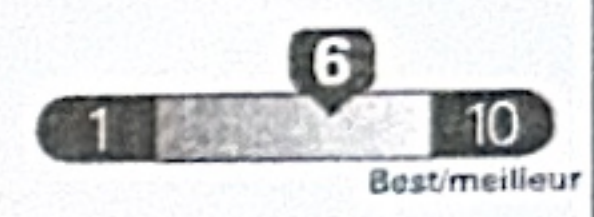

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF A QUIT CLAIM TRANSFER CONCERNING PART OF THE SHORE ROAD ALLOWANCE IN FRONT OF LOT 35, CONCESSION 11, PERRY, TOWN OF KEARNEY

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, R.S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its Council through the adoption of by-laws;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the said *Municipal Act, 2001* Council is empowered to sell any highway which has been closed and declared surplus;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Kearney (the "Corporation") passed by By-law 1990-16 authorizing the closure and conveyance to adjacent owners of part of the original unopened road allowance in front of Lot 35, Concession 11, Perry, now in the Town of Kearney including Part 1 42R10368, which By-law was registered on title on January 25, 1991, as Instrument No. RO135573;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation transferred part of the Road Allowance in front of Lot 35 Concession 11, Perry, being Part 1 42R10368 to the adjacent owners by a Transfer registered on May 16, 1991, as Instrument No. RO136849, which transfer excluded certain covenants;

AND WHEREAS Part 1 42R22327 is part of Part 1 42R10368 and the said Part 1 42R22327 is now owned by Justin James Chausse, Marsha Lee Chausse, Bradly Stephen Stallman and Laura Christine Fischer (the "Transferees");

AND WHEREAS the Transferees have requested that the Town issue a quit claim transfer for Part 1 42R22327 without any excluded covenants;

AND WHEREAS it is now deemed expedient to authorize the execution of the quit claim transfer in favour of the Transferees;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation's Sale of Land and Notice By-law do not apply with respect to this quit claim transfer as the land was previously closed and sold;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Kearney hereby enacts as follows:

1. Quit Claim – This Council does hereby authorize the transfer (by way of Quit Claim) of Part of the Road Allowance in front of Lot 35, Concession 11, Perry, closed by RO135573, designated as Part 1 on 42R22327; Town of Kearney, District of Parry Sound, being part of PIN 52159-0294 (R) to Justin James Chausse, Marsha Lee Chausse, Bradly Stephen Stallman and Laura Christine Fischer.
2. Execution of Documents – This Council does hereby authorize the Mayor and Clerk or Deputy Clerk to sign all documents and to take all action necessary to carry out the intent of this By-law.
